- ⊕ Fabric for lining one fat quarter or scraps at least 10" x 8"
- ⊕ Interfacing 10" x 16"
- ® Nylon zipper 9",10", 11" or longer
- 1 Thread to match your fabric.

- ⊕ 6-8 yards of assorted cotton selvage strips (20 strips at least 10-12" long, 1 1/4-2"wide)
- ② 2 9x12" sturdy cotton fabric for foundation
- 📵 Opional 2 9xl2" cotton fabric for lining white, cream, gray, or matching thread
- 📵 l filled bobbin
- ⊕ 9" or 12" zipper (depending on the size 😐 of pouch you wish to make)
